FOR APPLICANTS

In the course of your application, we process personal data for the purpose of selecting applicants. This involves general contact information (name, address, telephone number,...), any certificates or proof of qualifications and notes from an interview. This is done on the legal basis of pre-contractual measures and is necessary for the purpose of the processing. Any inspection of a criminal record extract is noted, but the information from the criminal record extract is not stored.

The processing takes place in the name of Boritea GmbH. As a matter of principle, the data will not be passed on to third parties unless this is required for legal reasons or necessary for the purpose of processing. It is also possible to pass on data to order processors who work exclusively on the instructions of Boritea GmbH, do not use the data for their own purposes and are bound by their own agreements to the data protection obligations of the General Data Protection Regulation.
